

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES WITH CANFRO IN CANADA

CANFRO is operated entirely by volunteers.

Here are the tasks that are not currently assigned to a volunteer.

- Grant writing: from your home research potential foundations, service clubs and international aid programs. Submit grant applications for the projects that meet the criteria.
- Publicity: write and produce a video celebrating the CANFRO projects that can be uploaded to the website and shown at public speaking engagements.
- Speech Writing: write a presentation that volunteers can deliver in their own communities to service clubs, women's groups and other organizations that may be potential donors.
- Public Speaking: present the CANFRO story in your community to service clubs, women's groups and community organizations that support international aid projects.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITES WITH CANFRO'S PARTNER AGENCIES IN OAXACA

If you are planning a trip to Oaxaca you may want to include some volunteer activities to make your experience meaningful and helpful. CANFRO does not have any staff and is not in a position to coordinate your time. However, CANFRO Project Managers can introduce you via email or in person to our partner agencies, some of whom do have the capacity to supervise volunteers with their clients.

The Book Project with Libros para Pueblos:

- January/February volunteer for a shift helping to sort, stamp and pack the books that will be distributed to the 74 libraries
- February volunteer for a shift helping the LPP staff with the annual Convivio held in the city of Oaxaca
- Saturdays at the Oaxaca Lending Library you can read to kids in Spanish

The Tutor Project with *The Oaxaca Learning Centre*:

- Volunteer to help a young person practice their English and they will help you with your Spanish
- If your Spanish is good enough share your skill set by offering a workshop or seminar

The Speech and Signing Therapy Project with The Centre for Rehabilitation of Hearing and Speech:

- Help fix and repair the building which suffered water damage during the wet season 2016-17
- Audiologists can assist with assessment of children and fitting of hearing aids
- Signers with Spanish Sign Language can teach family members to sign

The High School Project for Girls with Fondo Guadalupe Musalem:

- If your Spanish is good offer a workshop in Leadership, Community Change, Feminist Theory
- Interview one of the girls sponsored by Canadians and write an article for the CANFRO newsletter

The Food Project with The Centre for Hope for Children:

Help prepare food and assist with clean-up

The School Sponsorship Project with *The Centre for Hope for Children*:

- Offer your special skills in storytelling, puppetry, mask making, art, writing, board games such as backgammon and chess, computing, visual arts, graphic design and programming
- Provide math/science tutoring (in Spanish) to students
- Intercambio practise your Spanish and help a young person with their English
